OUTER AREAS REGISTRATION CONCESSION

COST: \$11.977 million over four years

A Malinauskas Labor Government will reintroduce the outer areas registration concession for owners of vehicles in remote regions such as Kangaroo Island, the District Council of Coober Pedy and Roxby Downs.

The benefit provides for a 50% reduction in registration fees for vehicles with a gross vehicle mass less than or equal to 4,500 kg and a 40% reduction in registration fees for vehicles with a gross vehicle mass over 4,500 kg.

The concession covers most vehicles, motorcycles or trailers that are usually kept and used wholly or mainly in outer these areas.

The concession acknowledges the additional running costs faced by vehicle owners living and using these vehicles in these areas.

The concession was cut by the Marshall Liberal Government in 2020.
